Island Arts Camp offers students finishing grades K-8 a chance to spend five days in one and two hour blocks creating art, performance, dance, and music with professional artists. Every child participates in a variety of activities at the Island Arts Camp,

giving participants a unique week's experience across many artistic disciplines.

This summer camp is designed for **fun** and **creativity**. Each day includes recitals, presentations, and time for outdoor exercise. Please provide your child with a healthy snack and a brown bag lunch. The campers are divided into groups of 10-12 students each, roughly on the basis of age and grade level. The day runs from at 9 am to 3 pm and is broken into four blocks with snack and lunch breaks, and, for the youngest campers, concludes with a one-hour story time and optional 2 pm pick-up.
